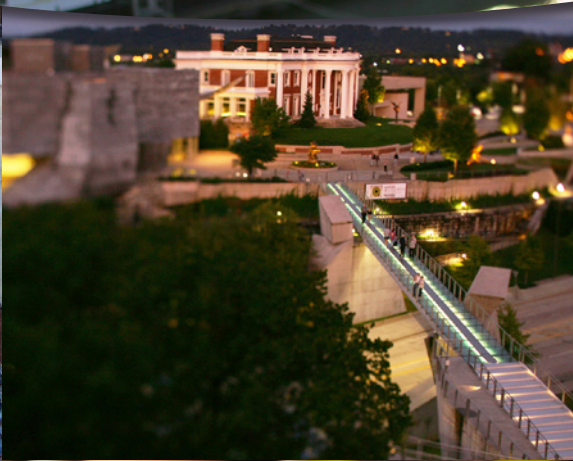


THREE DAYS OF ROMANCE
